

COVID-19 VACCINATION EXEMPTION

I, _____, under well-established International Human Rights Law and the Law of the United States of America, Hereby claim exemption from vaccination for any or all of the following reasons:

- **Ownership Of My Body:** This basic human right is the fundamental basis for the illegality of the most heinous of crimes against humanity, including slavery and rape. The Nuremberg Code explicitly states that "The voluntary consent of the human subject is absolutely essential". As owner of my body, I am refusing to allow myself to be injected with the COVID-19 vaccine.
- **My Welfare:** Given that absolutely no assurances whatsoever are made which guarantee that vaccination will not result in my death, incapacitation, or other detriment to my health, I do not consent to be vaccinated.
- **Welfare of Others:** I have a concern for the welfare of others. I am concerned about those who I will leave behind in the event that my vaccination results in my death. I am concerned about those who would be left to care for me in the event that my vaccination results in my incapacitation. I am concerned about how potential detriment to my health will affect those who depend upon me and those who I love. Furthermore, given the possibilities of self-dissemination and of vaccine-induced mutation, I do not believe that vaccination is socially responsible.
- **Ethics:** I am concerned about the ethical development and manufacturing of vaccines. Given that the COVID-19 vaccine is developed from human tissue derived from abortion, I am opposed to accepting the vaccine on ethical grounds. Tampering with one's DNA is also ethically objectionable. Given that mRNA vaccines do in fact tamper with one's DNA, I choose to reject the vaccine.
- **Science:** Science has no explanation for extensive cases of death and injury following the injection of the COVID-19 vaccine. This is very troubling, and clearly indicates that a scientific understanding of the vaccine is still premature. Furthermore, although there is merit to the hypothesis that vaccination is effective in providing immunity to infection, it has yet to be scientifically proven that vaccines are in fact equal or superior to naturally-developed immunities, a well-nourished immune system, good overall health, hygiene, effective sanitation, and a clean environment. Based on scientific evaluation, I choose to reject the COVID-19 vaccine.
- **Religion:** Religion is broadly defined under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Certainly ethics are fundamental to religion. At a minimum, my "ultimate ideas" about "life, purpose, and death" espouse the principles of America's Declaration of Independence: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness. — That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed." As such, my religious beliefs prevent me from being vaccinated.
